

Are schools allowed to bring in outside food?

Frontier League rules prohibit all outside food and drink. We will have our concession stands open for the duration of the game. We encourage groups to purchase the \$10 ticket package that includes lunch. We are also located next to Garvin Park, which features an ample amount of picnic space if schools choose to bring a lunch to eat outside of the ballpark.

*Exceptions are made for students with food allergies. Arrangements for this must be made in advance with Otters staff.

What happens if we experience inclement weather?

This is a rain or shine event, but we will do everything possible to get these games in. Our inflatables will remain open weather permitting. Lunch will still be served to all those who purchased the lunch option. In the event that we do cancel a game due to weather, each attendee will receive a ticket that can be used at any future Otters home game.

What if I have a student with food allergies?

Student well-being is a top priority. We allow students with food allergies to bring their own lunch to prevent any potential issues, but Otters staff must be notified in advance.

What is the earliest we can arrive?

Gates will open 1 hour before the scheduled game start time. Inflatables will be open upon arrival. Concessions will open closer to game time.

Can some students in my class purchase the lunch option while others do not?

Yes, your class can purchase both types of tickets. You do not have to purchase all of one or the other.

Is it a full game?

Yes, this will be a full 9 inning exhibition game. On average, games run for approximately 3 hours. We do allow re-entry to the park and your school will be free to leave whenever best fits your schedule.

Are the inflatables an additional fee?

No, the inflatables are free for this event! Please keep in mind that they are a popular activity, so please be patient when waiting to use them. Our staff will work to make sure everyone gets a fair turn.

Is this event open to the general public/will there be alcohol sales?

The general public will be able to purchase tickets for this game. We will do our best to accommodate ticket purchases for parent walk-ups but ask that parents be included in your chaperone numbers if possible. We will not be selling alcohol during this event. Additionally, we will have an increased security presence at the stadium for these games. The EVSC graciously allows us to utilize some school liaison officers in addition to our police deputies.

Payment options?

We ask that all registration forms are sent in ASAP. You do have the option to make a deposit to reserve your school's spot. Full payment is due by April 22, 2019. We accept all forms of payment. Checks should be made payable to Evansville Otters.
